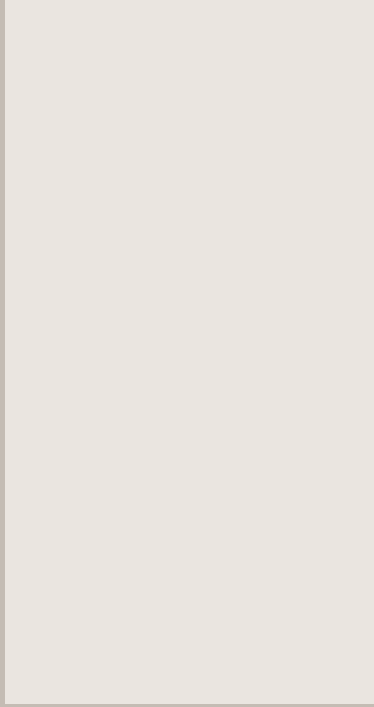
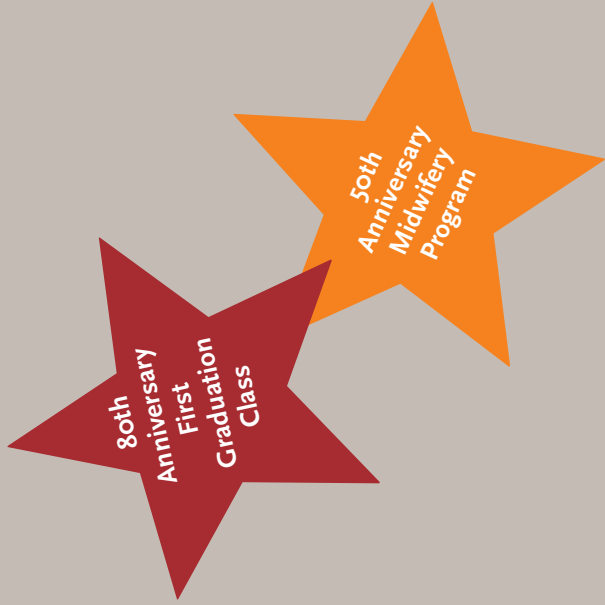
I-95 traveling north or south
