Dear International Student:

Yale School of Nursing (YSN) practices “need blind” admissions; in other words, an offer of admission is based entirely on your academic file, without regard to your ability to pay. If you need financial assistance, complete and mail two applications, both available on our web site: **YSN Financial Aid application** and the **International Student Financial Aid application**. These applications should be completed After January 1, 2008 and **postmarked by February 1, 2008**. Students admitted to the RN program and those admitted later than February 15 should complete their applications as soon as possible.

Once you are offered admission to YSN, my office will review your Financial Aid applications to determine your level of need. International students are eligible for YSN scholarship, but we can cover only a portion of your tuition.

You must secure full funding before we can issue the appropriate visa documents. We encourage you to seek support from your family or employer. We have a list of possible resources on our web page (“external sources of aid”). You will have some time to review your financial aid award before a deposit is required to hold your place in the class.
