The PhD in nursing at Yale University educates students in research, scholarship, teaching, and leadership. Particular emphasis is placed on scientific knowledge development that is consistent with YSN's mission of "better health for all," contributing to health over the life span, reducing health inequities, improving quality care, and shaping health policy. The full-time educational program includes course work, seminars, research assistantships, teaching fellowships, dissertation research, and mentorship by faculty experts.

The post-masters Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) Programs are designed for mid-career nurses. who wish to become innovative healthcare leaders and clinical innovators through building on their previous education and experience and gaining knowledge and practical experience here at YSN and in the field. Through collaboration with our faculty, health care leaders and practitioners, and policy advocates, our DNP graduates will create new nursing roles and models to contribute to better health for all people.

The Healthcare Leadership, Systems, and Policy DNP Program offers a unique focus on systems leadership and policy and is designed for nurses who wish to become innovative healthcare leaders in organizational and community context, executive practice, and policy.

The Post-Master's Clinical Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) Program is designed for Advanced Practice Nurses (APN) who have graduated from an MSN program and are interested in pursuing a program to enhance their clinical leadership skills and develop a clinical area of expertise in their practice area.
