Dear Students,

With various communications being sent recently, I wanted to highlight a few key updates:

- Per President Salovey's [message](#) today, all undergraduate, graduate, and professional school students who plan to be on campus are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 at the start of the fall 2021 semester. Please visit the [Yale COVID-19 Vaccine Program site](#) for additional information about the vaccine and scheduling.
- Per Dr. Christine Chen's [message on April 16th](#), special dedicated student vaccination clinics have been set up beginning Wednesday, April 21st. Please click on the message link for additional details.
- Individuals with COVID-19 vaccination performed outside of the Yale COVID-19 Vaccine Program may [voluntarily submit their COVID-19 vaccination record](#) to the university. By doing so, it will ensure that your vaccination status is on record with the university for COVID-19 monitoring across the Yale community. In addition, by using this link your record will be added to your Yale Health / Yale New Haven Health electronic health record and available to you within your MyChart account.
- Given the status of vaccinations and requirements, YSN will **stop the weekly testing requirement** for currently enrolled students. Students are encouraged to participate in voluntary testing per the [Yale screening program](#).
