**** ALL YSN STUDENTS ARE EDUCATED ON HIPAA REQUIREMENTS AND HAVE TAKEN AND PASSED THE YALE UNIVERSITY HIPAA TRAINING PROGRAM**

Required of ALL YSN Students

As a Condition of Enrollment

- 1) Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis
1 dose **Tdap within 10 years**
Td or TT NOT ACCEPTED
- 2) Mumps immunization OR history of illness;
- * 3) Measles (Rubeola) immunization
OR positive antibody titre
OR history of illness documented by the diagnosing physician;
- * 4) Rubella immunization
OR positive antibody titre
OR history of illness documented by the diagnosing physician;
- 5) Varicella (chicken pox) immunization
OR positive antibody titre
OR documented history;
- 6) PPD (Mantoux type);
- 7) Hepatitis B immunization vaccine
OR documentation of Hepatitis B positive antibody within the last year;
- 8) Physical Examination.
- 9) Criminal Offense Record Investigation (CORI) Background Checks
All students named on this Schedule A have a completed CORI background check in the State of Connecticut and the state in which the student resides. These CORI reports have been checked by the YSN Office of Clinical Affairs and Office of Academic Affairs staff and we attest that they are without criminal incidents or infractions.
- 10) In accordance with the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) of 1996, the Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health (HITECH Act) and Yale University training requirements, all students have completed HIPAA training regarding the **privacy, security and transaction standards** for the use and disclosure of individually identifiable protected health information (PHI).

Post-Enrollment

- 1) Completion of annual **SEASONAL INFLUENZA VACCINATION**
- 2) PPD (Mantoux type)
- 3) Education in blood-borne/universal precautions and airborne pathogens as outlined in the OSHA Standards.

Required of All Clinical Faculty:

- * 1) Measles (Rubeola) immunization
 OR positive antibody titre
 OR history of illness documented by the diagnosing physician;
- * 2) Rubella immunization
 OR positive antibody titre
 OR history of illness documented by the diagnosing physician;
- 3) Varicella (chicken pox) immunization
 OR positive antibody titre
 OR documented history;
- 4) Annual PPD (Mantoux type);
- 5) Hepatitis B immunization vaccine
 OR documentation of Hepatitis B positive antibody within the last year;
- 6) Education in bloodborne pathogens/universal precautions and airborne pathogens
 as outlined in the OSHA Standards.

*Those faculty and students born on or before December 31, 1956 are considered immune.
